Introducing Cerri, Educational Mental Health Practitioner, at both The Park and Parkwall Primary School. Cerri uses Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) techniques to support children in one-to-ones, groups, assemblies and more. Cerri will be running free parent/carers coffee afternoons at both schools to discuss children's mental health, ask questions and suggest ideas.
